University of Massachusetts, an MA from the University of Nebraska Omaha and in 1994 was awarded a PhD in theatre arts from the University of Oregon College of Arts and Sciences. Plays written by Rob Urbinati include an adaptation of August Strindberg's 1888 play *Miss Julie, Miss Julie in Hollywood* (1993), and *Hazelwood Jr. High* (1996).

Death by Design was written in 2010 and first performed in Houston Family Arts Center, and is currently being performed or planned across the US and UK including Manchester, Washington, Oregon and Montana. And of course West Bridgford!

Yes, it's me again, re-elected with a very small majority apparently!


